### "Good Touch & Bad Touch"

It is a growing concern among parents and teachers about the safety of children which has forced many schools to drop their tight-lipped approach towards sex education and teach the children about safe and unsafe touches. Every child needs to be taught that his/her body belongs to him/her and he/she has a right to protect it. With this in mind, and knowing that most of the children may not even be knowing when they are abused, Indo Scots Global School encouraged its staff to conduct a basic awareness programme on this theme for the learners.

The School organised an educative awareness workshop on "Good Touch and Bad Touch" on 16th October, 2020. Learners actively participated in the engaging workshop along with their parents where they were taught about their "Safe Zones". Teachers, in collaboration with Inner Wheel club of Thane Hills and in collaboration with an NGO Arpan worked on creating an awareness among the students about "Safe and Unsafe touch".

With the help of numerous videos, pictures, character play etc. students were taught how to differentiate and identify "bad touch" or "uncomfortable behaviour" from others. They were also given instructions on how to react or respond in an uncomfortable situation.

At the end of the session each child had to answer a questionnaire to review his/her understanding. It was a great initiative and a step further to spread awareness about 'Good and Bad Touch', one of the most sensitive issues in today's time. Also for children to understand the prevailing truth and essential guidelines to deal with the same, thus making themselves future ready.

The students confidently expressed their views on the same and uploaded their videos on Google Classroom.




